- **‘Bath & North East Somerset Council Corporate Strategy 2020-2024’ – have your say.** Bath & North East Somerset Council (B&NES) has published a draft Corporate Strategy for 2020-2024. This is the council's overarching strategic plan. It sets out what it plans to do, how it plans to do it, and how it will measure performance over the next four years.

The draft strategy proposes a new framework for what B&NES will focus on and how it will work:

- The Council has one overriding purpose – to improve people's lives. This brings together everything it does, from cleaning the streets to caring for older people. It is the foundation for its strategy and it will ensure that it drives its commitments, spending and service delivery.
- There are two core policies – tackling the climate and nature emergency and giving people a bigger say. These will shape everything the Council does.
- To translate its purpose into commitments, the Council has identified three principles. It wants to prepare for the future, deliver for local residents and focus on prevention.
