Local issues

- **Bath & North East Somerset Council 'Parking Permits Consultation' – have your say.** In our recently issued 'Spring 2021' Newsletter, we advised that Bath & North East Somerset Council (B&NES) was considering introducing changes to on-street parking arrangements. B&NES has now announced a consultation on its proposals. In this consultation, B&NES is asking for views on the following:
 - The introduction of a pricing structure for Residents' Parking Permits which is based on vehicle emissions.
 - Changes to how it manages and operates parking permits for hotels, guest houses and holiday lets, including removing hospitality visitor parking from on-street spaces to council-operated long-stay car parks.
 - Changes to how it manages and operates parking permits for medical and social care professionals.
 - A price review for a number of its parking permits.

CARA shall be responding to the consultation on behalf of its member base. We are currently reviewing the proposals in detail but, at this early stage, believe that there are key elements, such as the proposal to only allow hotels, guest houses and holiday lets permits in car parks, that are supportive of our goal to increase on-street parking supply for residents and their visitors.
