• Parking permit discounts for zero emission vehicles. B&NES Council is offering discounted parking permits in Bath for zero emissions vehicles. From Monday 1st April, a limited number of parking permits will be available at a reduced cost on a first-come first-served basis. The discount scheme is being funded by a £240,000 government grant designed to promote zero and Ultra Low Emission Vehicle (ULEV) uptake in advance of the introduction of a Clean Air Zone in the city centre.
